

How do I buy an artwork?

You can buy an artwork in person at The Library Project during the HALFTONE Print Fair or online at halftone.ie

When do I collect the artwork?

If you purchased a **framed** artwork, your artwork will be packed and ready for collection from the December 3rd during opening hours. We will take your contact details to remind you.

If you purchased an **unframed** artwork, you may take it away on payment.

Can you deliver my artwork?

For local delivery of framed works within Dublin, we offer a service for €25, from December 3rd.

For international delivery, courier service is arranged and costs are based on the artwork and delivery address. We can offer an estimate right away before purchase that will be adjusted once the artwork is ready for the courier. We successfully ship worldwide.

Are artworks framed

or unframed?

This booklet offer you the exact information for each artwork. Some are both framed and unframed, with the unframed copies available oftentimes immediately or on demand (expect a week turnaround), while others are only sold framed. We do our best to help you find the right artwork for you, so let us help you if in doubt.

All the artworks hanging on the walls remain on display until December 3rd. In some cases, a customer may need the artwork before that date for whatever reasons.
